DATA PROTECTION

In accordance with the principles of the UK General Data Protection Regulations (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018, your details will remain strictly confidential and only used by the Society for the purposes of managing your membership of the Society. Your data will not be shared externally except for the Society's nominated printer where you have chosen to receive the quarterly journal, "Liverpool Family Historian", by post.

If you fail to renew your membership for a period of three (3) years, your details will be removed from our database. If you Gift Aid subscriptions, the records will be retained for six (6) years after the last donation to comply with HMRC requirements.

GIFT AID

We can reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 of your subscription.

However, for this to happen, you must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in the UK for each tax year (6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities that you donate to will reclaim on your gifts for that tax year. Other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify.

- Change your name or home address.
- No longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.
